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


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Proposed Language Requests

1. **Governor's Task Force on Administrative Staffing**

There is established a Task Force on Administrative Staffing. The Office of State Employee Relations will be the lead staff agency of the task force. The task force will be made up of state agency representatives, including the University of Wisconsin system. The task force will study and make recommendations to the Governor on (1) appropriate administrative staffing levels throughout state government and (2) uniform administrative compensation levels across state government.

2. **Report on University of Wisconsin System faculty creation**

The University of Wisconsin System will report to the Secretary of the Department of Administration on how the additional 425 faculty positions were created for the period July 1, 2004 through July 1, 2006. The report will detail by position classification and campus the positions created during the reporting period. The report will be filed by the University of Wisconsin System by August 1, 2006.

3. **University of Wisconsin System administrative position reduction plan.**

The University of Wisconsin System will file with the Secretary of the Department of Administration a plan to eliminate 200 administrative positions from the University of Wisconsin position complement. The plan will designate by position classification and location the 200 administrative positions that are being eliminated. The plan will be submitted and approved by the Secretary by June 30, 2006. If the plan is not approved, position creation authority as authorized under section 242 (2p), 2001 Wisconsin Act 16 will be null and void for fiscal year 2006 -07.

Other Language Considerations

1. **Should there be language on resident undergraduate tuition levels?**

The issue is whether to cap tuition or not. There is currently no provision for tuition's share of any pay plan increase. Capping tuition may hamper the University's ability to provide the tuition share of any across-the-board pay plan increase.

2. **Should there be language on student access?**

This bill requires the Board of Regents (Board) of the University of Wisconsin System (UWS) to file a plan with the Department of Administration (DOA) to eliminate 200 UWS administrative positions. If the plan is not submitted by May 30, 2006, and approved by DOA by June 30, 2006, then for the 2006-07 fiscal year, the Board loses the authority, under current law, to create or abolish faculty and academic staff positions from general program operations funding.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
