We received this new request, BB0465, which looks a lot like BB0378 (LRB-1557). I can't tell whether this request is intended to replace BB0378 or to be a second "grant" and in addition to BB0378, i.e. do you want this as a new draft or do you want modifications made to LRB-1557? If the latter, it would be helpful if you could suggest exact changes to LRB-1557, as we are running out of time for repeated modifications..

Also, Peggy previously prepared a bonding authority draft, BB0285 (LRB-1056), that increased bonding authority to \$37,300,000. Is the reference in BB0465 meant to increase this bonding authority an additional \$2.1 million? If so, Peggy will redraft LRB-1056 with a new figure of \$39,400,000.

Please let me know. Thanks. (As I mentioned in my voice mail, we are running our compile at noon today, so accomplishing changes (not to mention new drafts) at this point is a challenge.)

Under current law, DOT, in consultation with the Wisconsin Coastal Management Council, administers a Harbor Assistance Program. Under the program, an eligible applicant may be awarded a grant to partially reimburse the applicant for expenses incurred in making certain harbor improvements. Eligible applicants include counties, cities, villages, towns, boards of harbor commissioners, and, with limitations, owners of a private harbor facility. DOT may contract up to \$28,000,000 in public debt (general obligation bonds) to provide grants for harbor improvements.

This bill requires DOT to award a grant, from general obligation bond proceeds, of ~~\$2,000,000 to a city that owns a harbor facility located on Lake Michigan for the purpose of constructing new boatlift facilities or improving existing boatlift facilities that serve or will serve at least two commercial enterprises that enhance economic development in this state.~~

#2,100,000 for a boat slip repair and reconstruction project in northeastern Wisconsin if the project is necessary to retain at least 2,500 jobs in this state.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 9148. Nonstatutory provisions; transportation.

(1) HARBOR ASSISTANCE PROGRAM. Notwithstanding any limitation specified in section 85.095 (2) (a) or (b) of the statutes, from the appropriation under section 20.866 (2) (uv) of the statutes, the department of transportation shall award a grant under section 85.095 (2) (a) of the statutes of ~~\$6,000,000~~^{2,100,000} in the 2005-07 fiscal biennium ~~to a city that owns a harbor facility located on Lake Michigan for the purpose of constructing new boatlift facilities or improving existing boatlift facilities that serve or will serve at least 2 commercial enterprises that enhance economic development~~ in this state.
