

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 16,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 100**

June 21, 2005 – Offered by Representatives PARISI and TOLES.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 33, line 22: delete that line and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 89d.** 16.964 (9) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 16.964 (9) (intro.) From the appropriations under s. 20.505 (6) (kp) and (p), the  
5 office of justice assistance shall provide ~~\$185,000~~ \$130,000 annually to the  
6 department of health and family services to distribute the following grants for  
7 children’s community programs:

8 **SECTION 89g.** 16.964 (9) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

9 **SECTION 89h.** 16.964 (9) (d) of the statutes is repealed.”.

10 **2.** Page 210, line 10: after that line insert:

11 “(kp) Anti–drug enforcement program,

12 penalty surcharge – local PR–S A 32,400 32,400”.

1           **3.** Page 210, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005–06 by  
2           \$28,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2006–07 by \$28,700 to  
3           increase funding for the Career Youth Development Center in the city of Milwaukee  
4           to operate a minority youth substance abuse treatment program.

5           **4.** Page 210, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005–06 by  
6           \$17,900 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2006–07 by \$17,900 to  
7           increase funding for court–appointed special advocate programs.

8           **5.** Page 311, line 9: delete that line and substitute:

9           “**SECTION 415p.** 20.505 (6) (j) 3. of the statutes is renumbered 20.455 (2) (i) 3.  
10          and amended to read:

11          20.455 (2) (i) 3. The amount transferred to ~~par. s. 20.505 (6)~~ (kp) shall be the  
12          amount in the schedule under ~~par. s. 20.505 (6)~~ (kp).”.

13          **6.** Page 312, line 24: delete that line and substitute:

14          “**SECTION 415z.** 20.505 (6) (kp) of the statutes is amended to read:

15          20.505 (6) (kp) *Anti–drug enforcement program, penalty surcharge — local.*

16          The amounts in the schedule to match federal funds made available under subtitle  
17          K of title I of P.L. 99–570. All moneys transferred from the appropriation account  
18          under ~~par. (j)~~ s. 20.455 (2) (i) 3. shall be credited to this appropriation account.”.

19          **7.** Page 848, line 3: delete lines 3 to 7 and substitute:

20          “**SECTION 2226t.** 302.05 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 302.05 (1) (a), and  
21          302.05 (1) (a) (intro.), as renumbered, is amended to read:

22          302.05 (1) (a) (intro.) The department of corrections and the department of  
23          health and family services may designate a section of a mental health institute as  
24          a correctional treatment facility for the treatment of substance abuse of inmates

1 transferred from Wisconsin state prisons. This section shall be administered by the  
2 department of corrections ~~and shall be known as the Wisconsin substance abuse~~  
3 ~~program~~. The department of corrections and the department of health and family  
4 services shall ensure that the residents at the institution and the residents in the  
5 substance abuse program:

6 **SECTION 2226v.** 302.05 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

7 302.05 (1) (b) The department of corrections may designate all or part of any  
8 state prison as a correctional treatment facility and provide, at that facility,  
9 programs for treating the abuse of alcohol or other drugs by inmates.”
