Increase funding for polluted run-off rules (#553): DNR Priority Watershed Program increase to \$6 million from \$4 mil; DNR Urban Runoff Program increase to \$4.7 million from \$1.5 mil; DATCP increase from \$7 million to \$5.5 mil

Restore Smart Growth current law and funding

Provide that DNR shall not proceed with the closure of any entry into a state park or close a state park without holding a public hearing in the local area of the park on the closure.

Provide that DNR shall not make any building expenditure and proceed with any building project unless it has been submitted to the JFC for approval
