 - **3.** Page 89, line 5: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005–06 by \$6,000,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2006–07 by \$6,000,000 to increase funding for the purpose for which the appropriation is made.
- **4.** Page 254, line 23: delete "<u>\$37,057,200</u>" and substitute "<u>\$46,590,500</u>".
 - **5.** Page 254, line 24: delete "\$39,280,600" and substitute "\$58,347,300".

6. Page 406, line 2: after that line insert:

"Section 726g. 39.435 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

- 39.435 **(3)** Grants under sub. (1) shall not be less than \$250 during any one academic year, unless the joint committee on finance approves an adjustment in the amount of the minimum grant. Grants under sub. (1) shall not exceed \$2,500 \$3,000 during any one academic year. The board shall, by rule, establish a reporting system to periodically provide student economic data and shall promulgate other rules the board deems necessary to assure uniform administration of the program.".
 - **7.** Page 406, line 13: delete lines 13 to 25.
 - **8.** Page 407, line 1: delete lines 1 to 19.
 - **9.** Page 1033, line 4: after that line insert:
- "(1k) Wisconsin higher education grants. The treatment of section 39.435 (3) of the statutes first applies to Wisconsin higher education grants awarded by the Higher Educational Aids Board for the 2005-06 academic year.".
