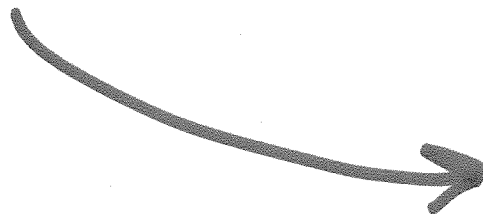

Please draft an amendment to restore the comprehensive planning statute (s.66.1001) and restore the \$2,000,000 in planning grants.

### **Nonpoint Program Bonding**

Reference: Paper #553, motion #572, Assembly amendment #22 (Black)

Please draft an amendment to restore the cuts to DNR/DATCP Nonpoint Program Bonding.

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**Recreate Office of Public Intervenor**

Reference: AB 205

Please draft an amendment to recreate the Office of Public Intervenor.

**Stewardship**

Reference: Assembly amendment #39 (Black)

Please draft an amendment to remove the JFC changes to Stewardship. Including the compulsory purchase language.

**Recycling Tipping Fees**

Reference: JFC #57, motion #286

Please draft an amendment to return the tipping fee and surcharge to current law levels and increase authority so that generated revenue is available for increased recycling grants to municipalities in the future.

**Public Benefits/Focus on Energy**

Reference: LFB #100, Assembly amendment #25 (Black)

Please draft an amendment to reverse taking funds from the Public Benefits Fund as proposed in the Governor's budget and reverse the motion passed by JFC (takes and additional \$1,909,000).

**Hiawatha Amtrak - Metra**

Reference: Motion 1300, Assembly amendment #35 (Colon)

Please draft an amendment to return Amtrak funding to level in Governor's budget.

**Waterway & Wetland Permit Fee Equity**

Reference: JFC paper #552

Please draft an amendment to eliminate the provision that an applicant pays only the single highest fee to apply for permits for multiple activities in or connected to lakes, streams, or wetlands. Applicants would pay a fee for

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each activity needing review. This change was suggested by a 2001 Legislative Council Special Study Committee
