Sen. Risser Budget Amendment

By request of the Wisconsin Council on Developmental Disabilities:

LFB Papers #360 (Autism slots)

#390 (Children's Long Term Care Waiver)

Provide that any unused funds allocated to the Children's In-Home Autism Treatment slots under the DHFS Children's Long Term Care Waiver should not be lapsed to the general fund: instead, use those funds to provide one-time funding for programs that serve children with other disabilities that are currently on **waiting lists**.

There is a precedent for this type of provision. There exists is a high cost Community Options Program (COP) fund where unused COP funds go into the one time cost fund for counties that have a high cost COP individual(s).

1. Page 454, line 13: after that line insert:

"SECTION 916m. 46.983 of the statutes is created to read:

**46.983 Children's long-term care waivers.** Counties may use unspent funds allocated by the department for the program under 2003 Wisconsin Act 33, section 9124 (8c) to provide one-time services under s. 46.985 or 2001 Act 16, section 9123 (16rs) to children who are on a waiting list to receive services under s. 46.985 or 2001 Act 16, section 9123 (16rs)."
