MSL DPI - Public library Funding - increase public library funding to 10% of costs. *13 - per the w Carrie Temple*

PG DPI - Mentoring grants for initial educators. Restore Gov's funding. Fund with GPR, not PR based on a \$50 increase in teacher license fees.

~~DHFS - Personal care funding - restore \$6.8 million that JFC cut and restore the Governor's definition as to what applied as personal care expenditures.~~

~~DWD/DVR - "Grandfather in" current DVR clients as to reimbursement rates for tuition, books, etc, if they are pursuing higher education. This would replace proposed reductions in reimbursement rates scheduled to go into effect on July 1, 2005.~~

PG DPI -Choice and Charter Schools: Require that the most senior administrator in each school in the Milwaukee parental choice program have at least two years of post-secondary education or a degree from an accredited instructions of higher education. (JEFF Motion #796 by Sen. Taylor (LRB 2895 - Peter Grant, drafter)

PL Intradistrict transportation for school children - Instruct school districts to issue one transportation payment per family when two or more children are attending the same school and their instruction begins at the same time. May have been requested by Sen. Taylor in JCF - LRB 2895, Peter Grants, drafter)

Badger Care: Exempt amount claimed for depreciation of farm equipment for purposes of calculating farm income under the BadgerCare (AB 16).

43.24 (1) (c) Beginning in the fiscal year in which the total amount of state aid appropriated for public library systems under s. 20.255 (3) (e) and (qm), as determined by the department, equals at least 11.25% of the total operating expenditures for public library services from local and county sources in the calendar year ending in that fiscal year, the amount paid to each system shall be determined by adding the result of each of the following calculations: 13%

1. Multiply the system's percentage of the state's population by the product of the amount appropriated under s. 20.255 (3) (e) and (qm) and 0.85.
2. Multiply the system's percentage of the state's geographical area by the product of the amount appropriated under s. 20.255 (3) (e) and (qm) and 0.075.
3. Divide the sum of the payments to the municipalities and counties in the system under subch. I of ch. 79 for the current fiscal year, as reflected in the statement of estimated payments under s. 79.015, by the total of all payments under subch. I of ch. 79 for the current fiscal year, as reflected in the statement of estimated payments under s. 79.015, and multiply the result by the product of the amount appropriated under s. 20.255 (3) (e) and (qm) and 0.075.
