

## 2005 SENATE BILL 263

1     **AN ACT relating to:** ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state  
2           of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, AFSCME Council 24,  
3           and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, for the 2003-05 biennium,  
4           covering employees in the security and public safety collective bargaining unit,  
5           and authorizing an expenditure of funds.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

6           **SECTION 1. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative  
7           agreement negotiated for the 2003-05 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the  
8           office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Employees Union,  
9           AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, covering  
10          employees in the security and public safety collective bargaining unit under  
11          subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the

1 security and public safety collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended  
2 by the joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary  
3 expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section  
4 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The  
5 director of the office of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the  
6 agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment  
7 relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the  
8 parties that is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the  
9 legislature under this act.

**SECTION 2. Effective date.**

11 (1) This act takes effect on the day following publication, except that those  
12 provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the agreement  
13 covering employees in the security and public safety collective bargaining unit are  
14 effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
