

**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,  
TO 2005 SENATE BILL 263**

July 20, 2005 – Offered by Senators BRESKE and DECKER.

1     **AN ACT** *to create* 20.255 (2) (ae) and 121.07 of the statutes; **relating to:**  
2             ratification of the agreement negotiated between the state of Wisconsin and the  
3             Wisconsin State Employees Union, AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate  
4             affiliated locals, AFL–CIO, for the 2003–05 biennium, covering employees in  
5             the security and public safety collective bargaining unit, authorizing an  
6             expenditure of funds, additional aid to school districts, and making an  
7             appropriation.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

8             **SECTION 1.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert  
9             the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

**SECTION 2.** 20.255 (2) (ae) of the statutes is created to read:

20.255 (2) (ae) *Additional aid*. The amounts in the schedule for additional aid to school districts under s. 121.107.

**SECTION 3.** 121.107 of the statutes is created to read:

**121.107 Additional aid.** In the 2005–06, 2006–07, and 2007–08 school years, from the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2) (ae), the department shall pay \$750,000 annually to any school district that meets all of the following criteria:

(1) The school district’s membership declined at least 12 percent between the 2001–02 school year and the 2003–04 school year.

(2) In the 2004–05 school year, the school district’s equalized value per member was less than \$600,000.

(3) The school district encompasses at least 475 square miles.

**SECTION 4. Agreement ratified.** The legislature ratifies the tentative agreement negotiated for the 2003–05 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, the office of state employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Employees Union, AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL–CIO, covering employees in the security and public safety collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employees of the security and public safety collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations, and authorizes the necessary

1 expenditure of moneys for implementation from the appropriations made by section  
2 20.865 (1) of the statutes, subject to section 20.865 (intro.) of the statutes. The  
3 director of the office of state employment relations shall file an official copy of the  
4 agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment  
5 relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the  
6 parties that is not a part of the official copy is deemed to be approved by the  
7 legislature under this act.

8 **SECTION 5. Effective date.**

9 (1) Section 4 of this act takes effect on the day following publication, except that  
10 those provisions specifically identified as having other effective dates in the  
11 agreement covering employees in the security and public safety collective bargaining  
12 unit are effective on the dates provided in that agreement.
