## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

OCI's direct responsibilities do not appear to have been altered significantly. However, the implementation of the cooperative plan will likely absorb resources for increased designation occurrences of geographic areas. Based on current staffing levels at OCI, and data currently available about the cooperative program, OCI estimates that there will be no additional state fiscal effect from the passage of LRB 05-0691/2 that cannot be absorbed in the current agency budget.
