Looks like the commingling prohibition, in its present form, could bar scattering cremated remains in a place where another person has already scattered the cremated remains of another decedent.

If this isn't intended, the bill could be amended to clarify that the commingling prohibition 1) only applies to person registered under s. 440.71 and their agents and contractors, or 2) does not apply to cremated remains that have been delivered by a crematory authority to another person.

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
