Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill, if enacted, would create a new crime and thus the possibility of additional cases being referred to district attorney' offices. There is no way to know the number of additional cases that might arise, but it would seem that the number would be small. Any person on probation who would knowingly violates this new sentencing provision is likely to also be violating other laws, so this would just be one more possible charge rather than an additional case.
