If the person asks for a deferral at least 30 days before the day of that hunting or trapping season, DNR shall defer the permit or license. Under the bill, a person whose permit or license is deferred has until the calendar year after the calendar year he or she ceased serving in the armed forces to apply for the permit or license that was deferred.
