Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law provides that in most municipal court actions, the filing fee must be at least \$15 but not more than \$23. This bill increases the upper limit to \$28.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 814.65 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

- 6 (b), if the person who committed the violation had a blood alcohol concentration of

of not less than \$15 nor more than \$23 \$28 on each separate matter, whether it is on default of appearance, a plea of guilty or no contest, on issuance of a warrant or summons, or the action is tried as a contested matter. Of each fee received by the judge under this subsection, the municipal treasurer shall pay monthly \$5 to the secretary of administration for deposit in the general fund and shall retain the balance for the use of the municipality.
