AN ACT to create 146.343 of the statutes; relating to: donation of newborn

umbilical cord blood.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires the principal prenatal health care provider of a woman who is known to be pregnant to offer her, before her 35th week of pregnancy, information on the options to donate, to an accepting and accredited cord blood bank, blood bank, blood center, or plasma center, blood extracted from the umbilical cord of her newborn child, if the donation may be made without monetary expense to the woman, to any insurer providing health care coverage for the woman, or to the hospital in which the delivery occurs for collection or storage. The requirement to offer a pregnant woman the option of donating umbilical cord blood does not apply to a hospital that, or physician, nurse—midwife, nurse, or other hospital employee or contractor who, in writing, refuses to participate in the activity by reason of religion or personal conviction.

1	146.343 Donation of newborn umbilical cord blood. (1) In this section:
2	(a) "Hospital" has the meaning given in s. 50.33 (2).

- (b) "Nurse" means a registered nurse who is licensed under s. 441.06 or permitted under s. 441.08.
- (c) "Nurse-midwife" means an individual who is licensed to engage in the practice of nurse-midwifery under s. 441.15 (3) (a).
 - (d) "Physician" has the meaning given in s. 448.01 (5).
- (2) Except as provided in sub. (3), the principal prenatal health care provider of a woman who is known to be pregnant shall, before the woman's 35th week of pregnancy, offer her information on options to donate, to an accepting and accredited cord blood bank, blood bank, blood center, or plasma center, blood extracted from the umbilical cord of her newborn child, if the donation may be made without monetary expense for the collection or storage to the woman, to any insurer providing health care coverage for the woman, or to the hospital in which delivery occurs.
- (3) Subsection (2) is inapplicable to a physician, nurse mid wife, nurse, or other hospital employee or contractor who, or a hospital that, in writing, refuses by reason of religion or personal conviction to participate in the activity specified in sub. (2).

Dear Colleague,

I am proposing legislation, which hopefully would help to save the lives of many people, especially children who suffer from leukemia and other types of blood related diseases.

The blood taken from the umbilical cord when a baby is born can be processed and used to treat leukemia and other diseases the same way bone marrow transplants are currently used. One problem is that there is not enough cord blood available.

Currently, after birth, the umbilical cord, which contains life-saving stem cells found in the cord blood is simply thrown away as medical waste. This bill would have the pregnant woman's physician or other health care professional let the woman know of the opportunity to donate her cord blood without cost.

These lifesaving stem cells are also valuable in the treatment of many other non-life threatening medical ailments. Also, these are non-embryonic stem cells. A number of pro-life groups are certainly in favor of this medical use of these <u>non-embryonic</u> stem cells.

Many hospitals and clinics around the country now process cord blood so it can be made available to doctors around the country. These clinics or cord blood centers will collect the blood from the donating mother or hospital for free. There would be no extra cost to the mother, the doctor, the hospital, or state government.

As this legislation goes through the approval process, it may be modified at the request of several doctor's groups to ensure that there is no additional liability or cost to the doctor. These would be certainly acceptable changes.

Thousands of people die each year because of dreaded leukemia. This bill will encourage the collection of more cord blood, which can help fight this battle to save lives. It is left up to the decision of the mother if she wishes to donate with no cost to the doctor or hospital.
