Technical Memorandum on 2005 AB 211 Regarding Collection of Fines, Fees,

and Forfeitures

Counties and municipalities can request the Department of Revenue (DOR) to collect certain unpaid debts through the refund intercept program. Under section 5 of the bill, the fees currently paid by counties and municipalities to use the system would be charged to the debtor.

Under current law, state agencies can also request DOR to collect certain unpaid debts through the refund intercept program. Fees for use of the system are paid by the state agency. Under the bill, state agencies would continue to pay these fees instead of the debtor. Is the differential treatment of fees for the use of the system by state agencies in comparison to counties and municipalities the intent of the author?
