

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 27

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 36.53 of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing a program for
2 tuition gift certificates at the University of Wisconsin System.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 36.53 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **36.53 Tuition gift certificates. (1)** The board may establish a gift certificate
5 program for the payment of nonresident tuition and academic fees. The program
6 shall include all of the following components:

7 (a) The individual named in a gift certificate may use the gift certificate to pay
8 all or a portion of his or her nonresident tuition or academic fees, or for a
9 study-abroad program, at any institution or college campus.

10 (b) A gift certificate is not transferable, except to a parent, child, spouse, or
11 sibling of the named individual in par. (a).

SECTION 1

1 (c) A gift certificate does not expire.

2 **(2)** (a) The board may charge no more than the actual processing cost as a fee
3 for each sale of a gift certificate.

4 (b) All moneys received by the board from the sales of gift certificates under this
5 section shall be credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.285 (1) (im).
