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**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 166**

April 27, 2005 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 29.889 (7m) (am) (title); and **to create** 29.885 (4r) and 29.889
2 (7m) (ar) of the statutes; **relating to:** wildlife damage claims and abatement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 29.885 (4r) of the statutes is created to read:

4 29.885 (4r) LAND NOT REQUIRED TO BE OPEN TO HUNTING. The requirements under
5 sub. (4m) do not apply to a person to whom the department grants a shooting permit
6 for deer causing damage that is issued as an abatement measure recommended
7 under s. 29.889 if all of the following apply:

8 (a) The permit is the only abatement measure the person receives under s.
9 29.889 for damage caused by deer.

10 (b) The person waives any eligibility to receive a wildlife damage claim
11 payment under s. 29.889 (7) for damage caused by deer.

12 **SECTION 2.** 29.889 (7m) (am) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
