The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 29.885 (4r) of the statutes is created to read:

4 29.885 (4r) LAND NOT REQUIRED TO BE OPEN TO HUNTING. The requirements to allow
5 hunting on property covered under sub. (4m) do not apply during the effective date of the
6 shooting permit to a person who receives a deer shooting permit issued as an abatement
7 measure recommended under s. 29.889 if all of the following apply:

8 (a) The deer shooting permit is the only abatement measure the person receives under
9 s. 29.889 for wildlife damage caused by deer.

10 (b) The person waives any eligibility the person may have to receive a claim payment
11 for wildlife damage caused by deer.

12 **SECTION 2.** 29.889 (7m) (am) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

13 29.889 (7m) (am) (title) *Exemption, apiaries.*
