Frequently, state agencies contract for contractual services because they require a service to be performed that they have never performed in-house and do not have the in-house capability to perform. In such a situation, it may be unreasonably expensive or unworkable to create an in-house capability. The type of analysis required by this amendment will not be possible to perform in this situation.
