1 **AN ACT to amend** 75.106 (1) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** the assignment of
2 property contaminated by hazardous substances.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 75.106 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
4 75.106 (1) (a) "Brownfield" has the meaning given in s. 560.13 (1) (a), except
5 that, for purposes of this section, "brownfield" also means abandoned, idle, or
6 underused residential facilities or sites, the expansion or redevelopment of which is
7 adversely affected by actual or perceived environmental contamination.
