

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 184

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 302.386 (5m) of the statutes; **relating to:** a prohibition against
2 using state funds or resources or federal funds to provide or to facilitate the
3 provision of hormonal therapy or sexual reassignment surgery to alter the
4 appearance of a prisoner or forensic patient so that the prisoner or forensic
5 patient appears more like the opposite gender.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 **SECTION 1.** 302.386 (5m) of the statutes is created to read:
7 302.386 **(5m)** (a) In this subsection:
8 1. “Hormonal therapy” means the use of hormones to stimulate the
9 development or alteration of a person’s sexual characteristics in order to alter the
10 person’s physical appearance so that the person appears more like the opposite
11 gender.
