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Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

On October 26, 2005 the Joint Committee on Finance introduced Assembly Amendment 2 to AB 618. The law currently requires a motor vehicle operator to "reasonably believe" that each passenger between the ages of 8 and 16 is properly restrained by seat belts. This amendment would delete this phrase and instead require that operators have each passenger who is at least 8 years old be properly restrained.

This amendment may impact the number of motor vehicle operators who can be charged with a violation of s. 347.48(2m), but it is impossible to make an exact estimate. The fiscal impact of the change is likely to be minor.
