Here are the answers:

1. State operated facilities should not be included since they are reimbursed on an actual cost basis and additional federal reimbursement is not needed.
2. The time period to calculate rates should be the time period covered by the 2004 cost report, which is used to calculate 2005-06 rates, and the 2004 cost reports are also used by DHFS to project county deficits in 2005-06.

Statutes don't refer to standard annual "cost reports" - cost info reported for "most recently completed fiscal year" - Are fiscal years consistent?

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: delete "county and municipal". ✓

3 **2.** Page 2, line 17: after that line insert:

4 "SECTION 2m. ✓ 49.45 ✓ (6u) (ag) 3. and 4. of the statutes are created to read:

5 49.45 (6u) (ag) 3. "Nursing home" has the meaning given in s. 50.01 (3). ✓

6 4. "State-operated nursing home" means a state center for the developmentally
7 disabled or a Wisconsin veterans home operated by the department of veterans
8 affairs under s. 45.50." ✓

9 **3.** Page 3, line 11: delete that line and substitute: "department shall disburse
10 to nursing homes, other than state-operated nursing homes, any". ✓

11 **4.** Page 3, line 14: delete "match" and substitute "matching funds". ✓

1 **5.** Page 3, line 15: after “received.” insert “The department shall disburse
2 funds under this paragraph to nursing homes, other than state-operated nursing
3 homes, in proportion to the number of patient days attributed to Medical Assistance
4 recipients in each nursing home’s most recently completed fiscal year. Funds
5 disbursed under this paragraph may only be used to reimburse costs of providing
6 direct care to Medical Assistance recipients.”.

Current law provides that the supplemental payments based on county and municipal operating deficits be paid to county and municipal "facilities." Facilities include nursing homes and community-based residential facilities (CBRFs). The amendment provides for any ~~un~~budgeted supplement to be paid to nursing homes only. It is my understanding that there currently are no county or municipal CBRFs, so applying the amendment to nursing homes only will not negatively impact ~~and~~ CBRFs.
