

**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 202**

May 19, 2005 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 12.

3 **2.** Page 2, line 14: on lines 14, 16 and 18, before “U.S.” insert “Students and
4 alumni of the”.

5 **3.** Page 3, line 2: before “Civil” insert “Members of the”.

6 **4.** Page 3, line 4: on lines 4 and 6, before “U.S.” insert “Students and alumni
7 of the”.

8 **5.** Page 3, line 15: after that line insert:

9 **“SECTION 9m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

10 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, if this subsection takes
11 effect in fiscal year 2006–07, in submitting information under section 16.42 of the
12 statutes for purposes of the 2007–09 biennial budget bill, the department of
13 transportation shall submit a dollar amount for the appropriation under section

1 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes that is \$18,200 less than the total amount appropriated
2 under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes for the 2006–07 fiscal year, before
3 submitting any information relating to any increase or decrease in the dollar amount
4 for that appropriation for the 2007–09 fiscal biennium.

5 **SECTION 1. Appropriation changes.**

6 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
7 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as
8 affected by the acts of 2005, the dollar amount is increased by \$18,200 for the fiscal
9 year in which this subsection takes effect to provide funding for computer
10 modification and license plate processing costs associated with the addition of special
11 group license plates under this act.”.
