If the issue is raised, the presiding officer may rule that this amendment is nongermane under assembly rule 54 (3) (f) on the grounds that the amendment substantially expands the scope of the substitute amendment in that the scope of the substitute amendment arguably is manufacturing methamphetamine in the presence of a child.

On the other hand, it can be argued that the scope of the substitute amendment is the safety of children whether that safety is endangered by the manufacturing of methamphetamine or easy access to firearms.
