

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 213

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: after “a child” insert “and the leaving or storing of a loaded  
3 firearm within the reach or easy access of a child under 14 years of age”.
- 4 **2.** Page 1, line 7: after “methamphetamine” insert “and over a child under 14  
5 years of age who obtains a loaded firearm that has been left or stored within the reach  
6 or easy access of the child”.
- 7 **3.** Page 2, line 8: after that line insert:  
8 “SECTION 1g. 48.02 (1) (gg) of the statutes is created to read:  
9 48.02 (1) (gg) Leaving or storing a loaded firearm within the reach or easy  
10 access of a child in violation of s. 948.55 (2) or (3).”
- 11 **4.** Page 3, line 3: delete “or (g).” and substitute “(g), or (gg).”.
- 12 **5.** Page 3, line 6: delete “or (g).” and substitute “(g), or (gg).”.

**6.** Page 3, line 15: after “(g),” insert “(gg),”.

**7.** Page 3, line 22: after that line insert:

3                   “(1m) LEAVING OR STORING LOADED FIREARM WITHIN REACH OR EASY ACCESS OF CHILD.  
4 This act first applies to abuse, as defined in section 48.02 (1) (gg) of the statutes, as  
5 created by this act, that occurs on the effective date of this subsection.”
