1 **AN ACT to amend** 346.94 (15) of the statutes; **relating to:** allowing school buses  
2 to tow trailers.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, no person may operate within this state a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached, except that a person may enter the state and operate a school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached if the school bus is registered in another state and that state's law permits the operation of the school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached.

This bill allows a person to operate any school bus with a trailer or semitrailer attached.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 **SECTION 1.** 346.94 (15) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 346.94 (15) TOWING BY BUSES OR HUMAN SERVICE VEHICLES. No person may

6 with any trailer or semitrailer attached. ~~This subsection does not apply to a school~~

5 subsection, but does not preclude the counting of other violations as prior violations  
6 for sentencing a person.


