9	is not discernable on the instrument.".
10	7. Page 3, line 3: delete "damages".
11	8. Page 3, line 4: delete "of not more than \$5,000, plus".
12	9. Page 3, line 5: delete lines 5 to 7 and substitute "being recorded.".

1	10. Page 3, line 7: after that line insert:
2	"(cm) If a register of deeds is presented with an instrument for recording that
3	contains an individual's social security number the register of deeds may, prior to
4	recording the instrument, remove or obscure characters from the social security
5	number such that the social security number is not discernable on the instrument.".
