

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 29

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 341.26 (2) (k) of the statutes; **relating to:** registration of
2 vehicles operated exclusively by volunteer fire departments and making an
3 appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 341.26 (2) (k) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 341.26 **(2)** (k) A fire truck or trailer owned and operated exclusively by an
6 incorporated volunteer fire department.

7 **SECTION 1g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

8 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, if this subsection takes
9 effect in fiscal year 2006–07, in submitting information under section 16.42 of the
10 statutes for purposes of the 2007–09 biennial budget bill, the department of

1 transportation shall submit a dollar amount for the appropriation under section
2 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes that is \$11,900 less than the total amount appropriated
3 under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes for the 2006–07 fiscal year, before
4 submitting any information relating to any increase or decrease in the dollar amount
5 for that appropriation for the 2007–09 fiscal biennium.

6 **SECTION 1r. Appropriation changes.**

7 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
8 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as
9 affected by the acts of 2005, the dollar amount is increased by \$11,900 for the fiscal
10 year in which this subsection takes effect to provide funding for computer
11 modification and data processing costs associated with the change in registration
12 procedure for vehicles registered under section 341.26 (2) (k) of the statutes, as
13 affected by this act.

14 **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

15 (1) This act first applies to applications for motor vehicle registration
16 submitted on the effective date of this subsection.
