10 land as a state forest, southern state forest, state park, state trail, state natural area,

The draft language that you provided with your drafting instructions for this amendment called for DNR to manage forest resources in a manner that is consistent with the "property's designation by statute, rule or the natural resources board." Please look closely at the language I used in the draft which is more specific than your language. I have assumed that by the use of the term "designation" you were referring to the designation of property as a state forest, state park, state natural area, or a similar kind of purpose-based designation. The use of the term "designation" without further description could be interpreted to include other kinds of designations such as geographical designation which I assume is not your intent. If my assumptions were incorrect and the draft does not reflect your intent, please let me know and I will redraft accordingly.
