Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB 750 would allow the Department to directly assess a forfeiture for license violations. Currently, the Department issues several trade-related licenses (e.g., plumber) and forfeitures for license violations are assessed by courts.

AB 750 indicates that the Department shall promulgate rules for forfeiture assessment. The Department anticipates that the associated workload can be absorbed within current resources.

The Department anticipates that forfeiture assessment would not be applied frequently (10-20 time annually). The Department anticipates no increased workload associated with the assessment of forfeitures.
