Hi Debora,

I need an amendment drafted for LRB 3062/2 - waiting for the bill number as of now.

LRB-3062/2 would be modified as follows:

- ✓ 1. Delete SECTIONS 12 and 13.
- ✓ 2. Page 8, lines 7 to 10 modify to also allow for reporting by fax or phone.
- ✓ 3. Page 9, line 12--include only diseases that require notification of DHFS under ch. HFS 145, Appendix A.
- ✓ 4. Page 5, line 16--insert "at least" before "every" and delete the words "for the following 10 years"
- ✗ 5. Strike the word "the" on page 6, line 8. This clarifies that not all of the objectives in the public health agenda would have to be met to qualify for a higher level designation; just those set forth by DHFS by rule.

Thank you so much for this. We are looking to have a hearing on this bill and amendment on January 11th. I am working on the notes you gave me for the other public health bill. Thank you again for all of this hard work.
