Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

This bill creates an overall prohibition that no person may operate a snowmobile at a speed exceeding 55 miles per hour during the hours of darkness (1/2 hour after sunset to 1/2 hour prior to sunrise). Wardens will enforce this law in an attempt to reduce the number of fatal snowmobile accidents which reached the second highest in history last snowmobile season.

The bill also creates a new GPR appropriation for snowmobile enforcement.

Fiscal Estimate:

The new appropriation and the \$32,700 GPR is for operation of the Accident Reduction Team which will operate this year in an attempt to reduce the number of fatal accidents. The funding will be one-time in FY 2006. The Team will need to prove successful in the reductions of accidents. If successful, the Department would seek permanent appropriations in future years.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

This is a one time/one year fiscal increase.
