Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county board may appropriate money for and create a county industrial development agency, or may appropriate money to a nonprofit agency, to foster industrial development in the county. An agency created by the county is a separate and distinct public instrumentality from the county. An agency may engage in a number of activities to promote industrial development in the county, including the following:

1. Grant financial aid to any industrial development project.

2. Acquire real or personal property; improve, clear, and redevelop the property; or sell, lease, or subdivide the property and make it available for industrial use.

3. Borrow money and issue debt, or loan money, to foster an industrial development project.

Currently, an "industrial development project" is defined as any site, structure, facility, or undertaking comprising or connected with an industrial or manufacturing enterprise that is established, or will be established, by an industrial development agency. Under this bill, the definition of "industrial development project" is expanded to include commercial, retail, agribusiness, or service enterprises. Also under this bill, an industrial development agency may not take any action that is described in item number to above, for an industrial development project that is a commercial retail, agribusiness, or service-related enterprise,

SECTION 1. 59.57 (2) (c) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

59.57 (2) (c) 3. "Industrial development project" means any site, structure, facility, or undertaking comprising or being connected with or being a part of an industrial or, manufacturing, commercial, retail, agribusiness, or service-related enterprise established or to be established by an industrial development agency.
