

Chris:

Carolyn in Rep. Hines' office called to make the following 2 requests:

1. Allow veterinarian technicians to administer rabies vaccine (to animals, not people), but only under supervision of a veterinarian. By "supervision", I think they mean that a veterinarian has to be present in the clinic when the vaccine is administered. Note that some statutes get particular when they talk about what constitutes supervision.

2. Amend s. 453.05 (2) (b) to delete the reference to cats and dogs. The result is that you can't castrate a cat or dog unless you are a licensed vet. You can, however, continue to castrate the rest of the animals listed without a license.

I told Carolyn that you are taking over the occupational reg. drafting, and that I'd pass these 2 requests on to you.

1 AN ACT ...; relating to: administering rabies vaccinations. ✓

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Under current law, an owner of a dog must have the dog vaccinated by a veterinarian against rabies. ✓ Current law also allows a certified veterinary technician to perform certain duties under the direct supervision of a licensed veterinarian. ✓

This bill allows a certified veterinary technician to administer a rabies vaccination to a dog under the direct supervision of a licensed veterinarian. ✓

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

2 SECTION 1. 95.21 (1) (em) of the statutes is created to read:

3 95.21 (1) (em) "Veterinary technician" has the meaning designated under s.  
4 453.02 (12). ✓

5 SECTION 2. 95.21 (2) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 95.21 (2) (a) *Requirement for vaccination.* Except as provided in s. 174.054, the  
7 owner of a dog shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian or a ✓

## SECTION 2

1 veterinary technician, pursuant to s. 453.05<sup>(2)</sup>~~(d)~~, at no later than 5 months of age and  
2 revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. If the owner obtains the  
3 dog or brings the dog into this state after the dog has reached 5 months of age, the  
4 owner shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies within 30 days after the dog is  
5 obtained or brought into the state unless the dog has been vaccinated as evidenced  
6 by a current certificate of rabies vaccination from this state or another state. The  
7 owner of a dog shall have the dog revaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian or  
8 a veterinary technician, pursuant to s. 453.05<sup>(2)</sup>~~(d)~~, before the date that the  
9 immunization expires as stated on the certificate of vaccination or, if no date is  
10 specified, within 3 years after the previous vaccination.

11 SECTION 3. 95.21 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 95.21 (2) (b) *Issuance of certificate of rabies vaccination.* A veterinarian or a  
13 veterinary technician, pursuant to s. 453.05<sup>(2)</sup>~~(d)~~, who vaccinates a dog against rabies  
14 shall complete and issue to the owner a certificate of rabies vaccination bearing a  
15 serial number and in the form approved by the department stating the owner's name  
16 and address, the name, sex, spayed or unspayed, neutered or unneutered, breed and  
17 color of the dog, the date of the vaccination, the type of rabies vaccine administered  
18 and the manufacturer's serial number, the date that the immunization expires as  
19 specified for that type of vaccine by the center for disease control of the U.S.  
20 department of health and human services and the city, village or town where the dog  
21 is required to be licensed.
