

Chris:

Carolyn in Rep. Hines' office called to make the following 2 requests:

1. Allow veterinarian technicians to administer rabies vaccine (to animals, not people), but only under supervision of a veterinarian. By "supervision", I think they mean that a veterinarian has to be present in the clinic when the vaccine is administered. Note that some statutes get particular when they talk about what constitutes supervision.
2. Amend s. 453.05 (2) (b) to delete the reference to cats and dogs. The result is that you can't castrate a cat or dog unless you are a licensed vet. You can, however, continue to castrate the rest of the animals listed without a license.

I told Carolyn that you are taking over the occupational reg. drafting, and that I'd pass these 2 requests on to you.

Under current law, a person may castrate a dog, cat, horse, pig, goat, sheep, or head of cattle without obtaining a veterinary license. This bill requires a person to obtain a veterinary license before he or she may castrate a dog or a cat. ✓

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 **SECTION 1.** 453.05 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 for dehorning or branding animals.
