Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent. Requiring DOT to generally consult with the state's veterans organizations would make the draft ambiguous and, to the extent it is interpreted to mean that DOT must consult with every state veterans organization before it could take action, could potentially be costly for DOT. I have tried to eliminate the ambiguity by requiring DOT to consult with at least two veterans organizations. Is this okay? The draft could also have specified a different number of veterans organizations or could require DOT to consult with all veterans organizations.
