From the appropriation under s. 20.465 (1) (am), the adjutant general or a designee shall purchase and issue the latest version of the highest quality body armor to every resident who is a member of the national guard or of a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces and who is called into the U.S. armed forces for combat duty.
