Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a student who is not a permanent resident of this state but who is a full-time undergraduate student at a college or university in this state that offers a bachelor's degree may be issued a resident fishing, small game hunting, or deer hunting license instead of a corresponding nonresident fishing or hunting license. The fees for these types of resident licenses are lower than those for the nonresident licenses.

Under this bill, a full-time student attending a college in this state that offers an associate degree is also eligible for these resident licenses. Also, under the bill, a postgraduate student is eligible for these licenses.
