

**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 479**

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 341.135 (1), 341.14 (6r) (c), 341.14 (6r) (e) and 341.14 (6r) (fm)
2 7.; and *to create* 20.380 (1) (ig), 20.380 (1) (ir), 25.40 (1) (a) 22., 41.24, 341.14
3 (6r) (b) 9. and 341.14 (6r) (f) 56. of the statutes; **relating to:** Golf Wisconsin
4 special distinguishing registration plates associated with the WPGA Junior
5 Foundation and the promotion of golf in this state and making appropriations.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6 **SECTION 1.** 20.380 (1) (ig) of the statutes is created to read:
7 20.380 (1) (ig) *Golf promotion.* All moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 9.
8 a. for the purpose of promoting golf in this state.
9 **SECTION 2.** 20.380 (1) (ir) of the statutes is created to read:

1 20.380 (1) (ir) *Payments to the WPGA Junior Foundation*. All moneys received
2 under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 9. b. for payments to the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. under
3 s. 41.24.

4 **SECTION 3.** 25.40 (1) (a) 22. of the statutes is created to read:

5 25.40 (1) (a) 22. Moneys received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 9. that are deposited
6 in the general fund and credited to the appropriation accounts under s. 20.380 (1) (ig)
7 and (ir).

8 **SECTION 4.** 41.24 of the statutes is created to read:

9 **41.24 Payments to the WPGA Junior Foundation.** (1) The department
10 shall enter into an agreement with the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. to make
11 payments from the appropriation under s. 20.380 (1) (ir) to the WPGA Junior
12 Foundation, Inc., to be used by the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. to fund its efforts
13 to provide opportunities, enjoyment, and education to junior golfers in this state.

14 (2) The agreement under this section shall require that the WPGA Junior
15 Foundation, Inc. provide, without fee and as a condition of receiving payments
16 specified under this section, any license or other approval required for use of any logo,
17 trademark, trade name, word, or symbol to be used on or in association with special
18 group registration plates under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 56.

19 (3) The agreement under this section shall require that the WPGA Junior
20 Foundation, Inc. annually submit to the attorney general and the presiding officer
21 of each house of the legislature an audited financial statement of its use of the
22 payments under this section, prepared in accordance with generally accepted
23 accounting principles.

1 **(4)** Payments to the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. under this section shall be
2 discontinued by the department if the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. dissolves or
3 is no longer exempt from taxation under section 501 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code.

4 **SECTION 5.** 341.135 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25,
5 is amended to read:

6 341.135 **(1)** DESIGN. Every 10th year, the department shall establish new
7 designs of registration plates to be issued under ss. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m),
8 (6m), and (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), and (j) and (2) (a), (b), and (c), and 341.26 (2) and
9 (3) (a) 1. and (am). Any design for registration plates issued for automobiles and for
10 vehicles registered on the basis of gross weight shall comply with the applicable
11 design requirements of ss. 341.12 (3), 341.13, and 341.14 (6r) (c) to (e). The designs
12 for registration plates specified in this subsection shall be as similar in appearance
13 as practicable during each 10–year design interval. Except as provided in s. 341.13
14 (2r), each registration plate issued under s. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m), (6m), or
15 (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), or (j) or (2) (a), (b), or (c), or 341.26 (2) or (3) (a) 1. or (am)
16 during each 10–year design interval shall be of the design established under this
17 subsection. The department may not redesign registration plates for the special
18 groups under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 53., 54., or 55. until July 1, 2010. Except for
19 registration plates issued under s. 341.14 (6r) (f) 53., 54., or 55., the first design cycle
20 for registration plates issued under ss. 341.14 (1a), (1m), (1q), (2), (2m), (6m), and
21 (6r), 341.25 (1) (a), (c), (h), and (j) and (2) (a), (b), and (c), and 341.26 (2) and (3) (a)
22 1. and (am) began July 1, 2000.

23 **SECTION 6.** 341.14 (6r) (b) 9. of the statutes is created to read:

24 341.14 **(6r)** (b) 9. An additional fee of \$25 that is in addition to the fee under
25 subd. 2. shall be charged for the issuance or renewal of a plate issued on an annual

1 basis for the special group specified under par. (f) 56. An additional fee of \$50 that
2 is in addition to the fee under subd. 2. shall be charged for the issuance or renewal
3 of a plate issued on the biennial basis for the special group specified under par. (f) 56.
4 if the plate is issued or renewed during the first year of the biennial registration
5 period or \$25 for the issuance or renewal if the plate is issued or renewed during the
6 2nd year of the biennial registration period. To the extent permitted under ch. 71,
7 the fee under this subdivision is deductible as a charitable contribution for purposes
8 of the taxes under ch. 71. All moneys received under this subdivision, in excess of
9 \$43,600 for the initial costs of production of the special group plate under par. (f) 56.,
10 shall be deposited in the general fund and credited as follows:

11 a. Twenty–five percent shall be credited to the appropriation account under s.
12 20.380 (1) (ig).

13 b. Seventy–five percent shall be credited to the appropriation account under
14 s. 20.380 (1) (ir).

15 **SECTION 7.** 341.14 (6r) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

16 341.14 **(6r)** (c) Special group plates shall display the word “Wisconsin”, the
17 name of the applicable authorized special group, a symbol representing the special
18 group, not exceeding one position, and identifying letters or numbers or both, not
19 exceeding 6 positions and not less than one position. The department shall specify
20 the design for special group plates, but the department shall consult the president
21 of the University of Wisconsin System before specifying the word or symbol used to
22 identify the special groups under par. (f) 35. to 47., the secretary of natural resources
23 before specifying the word or symbol used to identify for the special group under par.
24 (f) 50. and, the chief executive officer of the professional football team and an
25 authorized representative of the league of professional football teams described in

1 s. 229.823 to which that team belongs before specifying the design for the applicable
2 special group plate under par. (f) 55., and the department of tourism and chief
3 executive officer of the organization specified in par. (f) 56. before specifying the
4 design and word or symbol used to identify the special group name for special group
5 plates under par. (f) 56. Special group plates under par. (f) 50. shall be as similar as
6 possible to regular registration plates in color and design.

7 **SECTION 8.** 341.14 (6r) (e) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 341.14 **(6r)** (e) The department shall specify one combination of colors for
9 special group plates for groups or organizations which are not military in nature and
10 not special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. and 50. and for each professional
11 football team under par. (f) 55. The department shall specify one combination of
12 colors for special group plates under par. (f) 35. to 47. The Subject to par. (c), the
13 department shall specify the word or words comprising the special group name and
14 the symbol to be displayed upon special group plates for a group or organization
15 which is not military in nature after consultation with the chief executive officer in
16 this state of the group or organization. The department shall require that the word
17 or words and symbol for a university specified under par. (f) 35. to 47. be a
18 registration decal or tag and affixed to the special group plate and be of the colors for
19 a university specified under par. (f) 35. to 47. that the president of the University of
20 Wisconsin System specifies.

21 **SECTION 9.** 341.14 (6r) (f) 56. of the statutes is created to read:

22 341.14 **(6r)** (f) 56. Persons interested in obtaining a plate supporting the efforts
23 of the WPGA Junior Foundation, Inc. to provide opportunities, enjoyment, and
24 education to junior golfers in this state and promoting golf in this state.

25 **SECTION 10.** 341.14 (6r) (fm) 7. of the statutes is amended to read:

1 341.14 **(6r)** (fm) 7. ~~Except for the authorized special group enumerated under~~
2 ~~par. (f) 55.,~~ after After October 1, 1998, additional authorized special groups may
3 only be special groups designated by the department under this paragraph. The
4 authorized special groups enumerated in par. (f) shall be limited solely to those
5 special groups specified under par. (f) on October 1, 1998, ~~except for the authorized~~
6 ~~special group enumerated under par. (f) 55.~~ This subdivision does not apply to the
7 special ~~group~~ groups specified under par. (f) 54., 55., and 56.

8 **SECTION 11. Nonstatutory provisions.**

9 (2) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, if this subsection takes
10 effect in fiscal year 2006–07, in submitting information under section 16.42 of the
11 statutes for purposes of the 2007–09 biennial budget bill, the department of
12 transportation shall submit a dollar amount for the appropriation under section
13 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes that is \$43,600 less than the total amount appropriated
14 under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes for the 2006–07 fiscal year, before
15 submitting any information relating to any increase or decrease in the dollar amount
16 for that appropriation for the 2007–09 fiscal biennium.

17 **SECTION 12. Appropriation changes.**

18 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
19 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as
20 affected by the acts of 2005, the dollar amount is increased by \$43,600 for the fiscal
21 year in which this subsection takes effect to increase funding for special
22 distinguishing registration plates associated with the WPGA Junior Foundation,
23 Inc., and the promotion of golf.
