Created in 2000, the Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation has been dedicated to its mission of providing positive opportunities, enjoyment and education to junior golfers statewide. We accomplish this by providing golf tournaments, clinics, camps, academies, scholarships, grants, and other necessary vehicles to encourage and promote the game of golf. The game of golf is a wonderful developmental tool that helps teach life skills and lessons that last a lifetime.

Since 2000, the Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation has administered over 275 junior golf tournaments, conducted over 1000 free lessons and clinics, and awarded over \$50,000 in scholarships and grants. Over 15,000 individuals have participated in some Junior Foundation program in the last five years. Our programs reach individuals in areas statewide. From Kenosha to Hayward, our programs are helping to grow this wonderful game of golf and our future is as bright as ever.

As part of the "Golf Wisconsin" license plate program we envision the proceeds to go to expand all of our statewide programs. In particular we will use the funds to expand our Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation Grant Program. Under current law, any group or organization may apply to the Department of Transportation (DOT) for designation as an authorized special group. ✓ If the application is approved, members of the authorized special group may obtain special distinguishing license plates for certain vehicles, including automobiles and motor homes that are owned or leased by special group members. ✓ A fee, in addition to the regular registration fee for the particular kind of vehicle, is assessed for the issuance or reissuance of most special plates. ✓

Before October 2, 1998, authorized special groups whose members may obtain special distinguishing license plates were specifically enumerated in state law. ✓ Current law provides that specific enumeration in state law of authorized special groups is limited to those special groups enumerated before October 2, 1998. Members of six special groups enumerated in state law pay an additional annual fee as a tax deductible contribution. ✓

This bill establishes an authorized special group specifically enumerated in state law for persons interested in obtaining special distinguishing registration

The bill requires DOT to enter into an agreement with the ~~Komen~~ Foundation with respect to these funds, and the agreement must grant DOT authority, without fee to DOT, to use any applicable trademark of the ~~Komen~~ Foundation with respect to the special plates. The bill also requires the ~~Komen~~ Foundation to annually submit an audited financial statement of its use of these funds, and discontinues funding if the ~~Komen~~ Foundation dissolves or loses its tax-exempt status under federal law.

Luanne, I can get the figures from last year, will send as soon as I can.

A couple of things occurred to me after our meeting: One, with regard to Aaron's question about the contributions and the appropriation being to the Transportation Fund, there is a technicality that I forgot about yesterday, but I think this is what Aaron was referring to...I believe the contribution amount actually goes into the General Fund, not the Transportation Fund. We will need to be sure that when we appropriate funds into DMV's appropriation to pay the 1-time cost of up to \$27,600, that it comes from the correct Fund. This is so technical that I'd like to have our department's budget analyst Karen Baetsen participate in the discussion. Also, I wonder, if you could share the draft with us, we'd appreciate the chance to review it, before you introduce it. thanks.

Also, one other item: it occurred to me that when you were talking about "mock-up" of the plate, really the only design issue is what the logo would look like, since as I mentioned the background will be white, the standard design format for special plates. The legend at the top and bottom seem fine to our plate program manager, although the bottom logo would also be in red. I think we'd prefer not to start working actively on a logo until after the bill is enacted because if it doesn't pass we would not have a way to recoup our costs. Once the bill were passed, we'd begin working with you and with Dept of Tourism.

Under current law, any group or organization may apply to the Department of Transportation (DOT) for designation as an authorized special group. If the application is approved, members of the authorized special group may obtain special distinguishing license plates for certain vehicles, including automobiles and motor homes that are owned or leased by special group members. A fee, in addition to the regular registration fee for the particular kind of vehicle, is assessed for the issuance or reissuance of most special plates.

Before October 2, 1998, authorized special groups whose members may obtain special distinguishing license plates were specifically enumerated in state law. Current law provides that specific enumeration in state law of authorized special groups is limited to those special groups enumerated before October 2, 1998. Members of six special groups enumerated in state law pay an additional annual fee as a tax deductible contribution.

This bill establishes an authorized special group specifically enumerated in state law for persons interested in obtaining special distinguishing registration plates supporting the efforts of the Wisconsin PGA Junior Foundation (Foundation) to provide opportunities, enjoyment, and education to junior golfers in this state.
