The 2005–07 Budget Bill (Act 25) increased the license plate redesign period from 7 years to 10 years. The attached amendment reconciles the license plate redesign provisions of ASA1 to AB–479 with provisions in the Budget Bill. While the changes to s. 341.135 (1) made by the attached amendment could have been made by the Revisor of Statutes, the premise underlying SECTION 11 (1) of ASA1 to AB–479 is that these Golf Wisconsin plates should not have to be redesigned in less than two years. However, given the extension of the current redesign interval from 2007 to 2010, this nonstatutory provision is, as discussed, deleted by the attached amendment, so that the Golf Wisconsin plates will be redesigned in 2010 like most of the other special plates. I note that the attached amendment does not change the statutory numbering in ASA1 to AB–479 of s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 9. and (f) 56.; although these statutory numbers were used in the Budget Bill, the Revisor of Statutes may easily renumber these provisions. The treatment of SECTION 11 (1), however, is a substantive change that could not be accomplished by the Revisor.
