1 **AN ACT relating to:** fee remissions at technical colleges for victims of Hurricane

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the director of the technical college system to allow district boards to remit nonresident fees to a number of needy and worthy students as long as the total number of students receiving such fee remissions in all districts does not exceed 0.5 percent of the full-time equivalent statewide enrollment.

This bill authorizes the state director to exceed that limit in the 2005-06, 2006-07, and 2007-08 academic years in order to grant fee remissions to victims of Hurricane Katrina.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
