Analysis

Current law <sup>authorizes</sup> authorizes the director of the technical college system to allow district boards to <sup>remit</sup> remit nonresident <sup>fees</sup> fees to a number of <sup>needy and worthy students</sup> needy and worthy students as long as <sup>needy and worthy students</sup> as long as the total number of students receiving such fee remissions in all districts does not exceed 0.5 percent of the full-time equivalent statewide enrollment.

This bill authorizes the state director to exceed that limit <sup>in order to grant</sup> in order to grant fee remissions to <sup>grant</sup> fee remissions to victims of Hurricane Katrina.
