**SECTION 1.** 939.623 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 939.623 (2) (a) and amended to read:

939.623 **(2)** (a) If Except as provided in par. (b), if a person has one or more prior convictions for a serious sex crime and subsequently commits a serious sex crime, the court shall impose a bifurcated sentence under s. 973.01. The term of confinement in prison portion of a bifurcated sentence imposed under this subsection may not be less than 3 years and 6 months, but otherwise the penalties for the crime apply,

subject to any applicable penalty enhancement.	The court may not place the
defendant on probation.	

**SECTION 2.** 939.623 (2) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

939.623 **(2)** (b) If a person has one or more prior convictions for a violation of s. 940.225 (1) or for a comparable crime under federal law or the law of any state and subsequently is convicted of a violation of s. 940.225 (1), the maximum term of imprisonment for the violation of s. 940.225 (1) is life imprisonment without the possibility of parole or extended supervision.
