20	SECTION 5. 948.01 (5) (c) of the statutes is created to read:

22	complainant or sexually arousing or gratifying the defendant, intentionally causing
23	the complainant to ejaculate or emit urine or feces on any part of the defendant's
24	body, whether clothed or unclothed.
