Representative Gunderson would like an amendment drafted for AB 131 (LRB1002/1). Please change the effective date to April 1, 2006. Also, The DNR would like the following change made: THE EXCEPTION GRANTED (PAGE 3, LINE 9) TO ALLOW NON-RESIDENTS WHO TAKE A WISCONSIN TRAPPER EDUCATION COURSE TO TRAP WITHOUT PURCHASING A NON-RESIDENT LICENSE SHOULD BE ELIMINATED. THIS WOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH A HUNTER'S EDUCATION CERTIFICATE WHERE A RESIDENT MAY USE THE CERTIFICATE IN PLACE OF A SMALL GAME LICENSE (S. 29.591(4)(A)2., STATS.). BY ALLOWING NONRESIDENT TRAPPERS TO TRAP IN WISCONSIN FOR FREE WILL LIKELY BE THE CAUSE OF CONCERN TO SOME FROM THE WISCONSIN TRAPPERS ASSOCIATION AND TRAPPERS IN GENERAL. ALLOWING A NON-RESIDENT THE ABILITY TO USE TRAPPER CERTIFICATION AS THEIR LICENSE THE FIRST YEAR, THUS GETTING A \$149.25 LICENSE FOR FREE, COULD CREATE THE "GO TO WISCONSIN AND TRAP FOR FREE ONE YEAR" MENTALITY. Mike, when we testified on AB 131 we recommended a few minor modifications that those testifying, the Assembly Nat. Res. Committee and that Rep. Gunderson seemed agreeable to. I see that AB 131 has been forwarded to Joint Finance and I was wondering if any of the following recommendations were included in that draft. If not, is there still time to incorporate these provisions?

Excerpt from DNR testimony...

THE DEPARTMENT RECOMMENDS THE FOLLOWING TWO MODIFICATION TO THE EXISTING BILL (AB 131):

1. THE EFFECTIVE DATE BE CHANGED TO APRIL 1, 2006 TO ALLOW TIME TO DEVELOP FUNCTIONALITY WITH OUR AUTOMATED LICENSE ISSUANCE SYSTEM. OUR SOFTWARE DOWNLOAD FOR THIS LICENSE YEAR HAS ALREADY BEEN DONE, AND THE ADDITION OF THIS NEW LICENSE TYPE AND ANY ASSOCIATED PROGRAMMING WOULD BE DIFFICULT AND EXPENSIVE TO ADMINISTER FOR THE 2005 LICENSE YEAR. BY MOVING THE EFFECTIVE DATE TO APRIL 1, 2006, IT WILL ALLOW US TO BUILD IN THE NECESSARY FUNCTIONALITY TO THE AUTOMATED LICENSING SYSTEM.

2. THE EXCEPTION GRANTED (PAGE 3, LINE 9) TO ALLOW NON-RESIDENTS WHO TAKE A WISCONSIN TRAPPER EDUCATION COURSE TO TRAP WITHOUT PURCHASING A NON-RESIDENT LICENSE SHOULD BE ELIMINATED. THIS WOULD BE CONSISTENT WITH A HUNTER'S EDUCATION CERTIFICATE WHERE A RESIDENT MAY USE THE CERTIFICATE IN PLACE OF A SMALL GAME LICENSE (S. 29.591(4)(A)2., STATS.). BY ALLOWING NONRESIDENT TRAPPERS TO TRAP IN WISCONSIN FOR FREE WILL LIKELY BE THE CAUSE OF CONCERN TO SOME FROM THE WISCONSIN TRAPPERS ASSOCIATION AND TRAPPERS IN GENERAL. ALLOWING A NON-RESIDENT THE ABILITY TO USE TRAPPER CERTIFICATION AS THEIR LICENSE THE FIRST YEAR, THUS

GETTING A \$149.25 LICENSE FOR FREE, COULD CREATE THE "GO TO WISCONSIN AND TRAP FOR FREE ONE YEAR" MENTALITY.
