

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 800

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 29.304 (3) (a) 2., 29.304 (3) (b) 3., 29.593 (2), 29.593 (2m) and
2 29.595 (3) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** exceptions to requirements for
3 issuance of a certificate of accomplishment for successful completion of certain
4 hunter education programs.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 29.304 (3) (a) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:
6 29.304 **(3)** (a) 2. Is issued a certificate of accomplishment that states that he
7 or she successfully completed the course of instruction under the hunter education
8 program or has a similar certificate issued by, license, or other evidence satisfactory
9 to the department indicating that he or she has successfully completed in another
10 state, country, or province a hunter education course recognized by the department.

1 **SECTION 2.** 29.304 (3) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

2 29.304 **(3)** (b) 3. Is issued a certificate of accomplishment that states that he
3 or she successfully completed the course of instruction under the hunter education
4 program or has a similar certificate issued by, license, or other evidence satisfactory
5 to the department indicating that he or she has successfully completed in another
6 state, country, or province a hunter education course recognized by the department.

7 **SECTION 3.** 29.593 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 29.593 **(2)** A person who has a certificate, license, or other evidence that is
9 satisfactory to the department indicating that he or she has successfully completed
10 in another state, country, or province a hunter safety education course and if the
11 course is recognized by the department under a reciprocity agreement, the person
12 may obtain an approval authorizing hunting.

13 **SECTION 4.** 29.593 (2m) of the statutes is amended to read:

14 29.593 **(2m)** A person who has a certificate, license, or other evidence that is
15 satisfactory to the department indicating that he or she has successfully completed
16 in another state, country, or province a bow hunter education course and if the course
17 is recognized by the department under a reciprocity agreement, the person may
18 obtain a resident or nonresident an archer hunting license regardless of whether the
19 ~~person is issued a certificate of accomplishment for successfully completing the~~
20 ~~course of instruction under the bow hunter education program in this state.~~

21 **SECTION 5.** 29.595 (3) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

22 29.595 **(3)** (c) A person ~~may be issued an elk hunting license if the person holds~~
23 ~~evidence that demonstrates~~ who has a certificate, license, or other evidence that is
24 satisfactory to the satisfaction of the department indicating that he or she has
25 successfully completed in another state, country, or province an elk hunter education
